PLANNING TEAM MEETING OCTOBER 27.1991

The second Planning Team meeting was held in St. Monica's rectory on Sunday, Oct. 27,1991 at 1:30 P.M.

Minutes: p.1, line 10, add "planning" between the...team. p.1, line 11, add Pastoral Center between The...team.

Concerns were voiced about the procedures and processes for setting up the parameters by the Pastoral Center team. Kathy cannon explained that the Planning Team organization at the Pastoral Center was not a set group but was flexible so that it could include those individuals who possess concrete knowledge of the concerns of the parishes involved. Kathy assumed the three pastors will be invited to be present at the Pastoral Center team's initial stages of setting parameters which should be reactive to the parishes needs rather rhan conclusive. Kathy asked Fr. Fleming if his parish was ready to make a commitment to our group so that the Pastoral Center team would know whether to work on one model or two models.

Fr. Fleming expressed concern about providing members for the planning team as interpreters for his people cannot work for more than 30 to 45 minutes. He felt his parish is optimistic and enthusiastic over the change. He would have a clearer picture after his Parish Council meeting tomorrow. Since the three parishes have already invited his parish into the process we will be as helpful as possible to facilitate his community's familiarizing themselves with us. As to whether we are communities St.Mary's needs, Father stated that about 25% of his parish is or has been from the 19th Ward.

Karen Miller presented a breakdown of need and staff into categories. These are attached separately. OLGC shares the Youth Minister but has a separate Religious Education person.

Each parish has its own uniqueness in the area of liturgy and it should remain that way.

In the area of Social Justice consolidation of Social Justice committees should be considered in some particular areas rather than each parish dealing with the same issue using three different people. How to address the needs of Social Justice and how it will effect the staff needs to be considered. Will one group instead of three be more difficult or easier? How will the focus of the staff person be determined? Father Ring will prepare a breakdown into ministry and staff persons.

The Pastoral Review Reports showing the long range and short range goals were presented. All parishes have worked on the short range goals. See attached PRR sheet. As to change in the 19th Ward Kathy Cannon presented a packet of statistical data compiled by Fr. Peter Bayer based on the 1980 census which includes demographics, total parishes in the area, housing statistics, etc. According to the 1980 census OLGC had 80% home ownership and 17% non-owned while both St. Augustine's and St. Monica's had 55% home ownership and 45% rental property. Sharon will break down these statistics for us.

Both Fr. Bayer and Kathy will try to obtain 1990 census data and maybe 1992 projections. Also Fr. Bayer may obtain an ethnic make-up of the area. OLGC would like an accurate determination of its parish boundaries. The opening of the footbridge over the river to the U of R could change the current make-up of the 19th Ward. We need information on planned development.

Prayer services and future parish gatherings were determined. Each parish will schedule one for its own people and then have a common meeting. Ongoing projects are prayers of the faithful, homily references, Holy Day schedules. In November OLGC will expand their Nov. 21st Soup Supper to a joint parish project. It will start with mass at 5:30 P.M. with supper about 6 P.M. and a speaker from St. Joseph's House of Hospitality. Program runs to 7:30 P.M. There is a donation at the door.

OLGC and St. Monica's will schedule a parish convocation at the end of the month. In December a pulpit exchange will take place the second week, Dec. 7 & 8th to have the people experience different styles of worship. A Holy Hour will be scheduled and a 4 parish meeting will be held at St. Augustine's on Dec. 8th. In January a convocation in prayer will be held at St. Monica's on the 12th. St.Mary's will do the liturgy.

An overview of Bishop Clark's letter was tabled until the next meeting. Each parish will provide and outline on items a to d.

Sr. Mary Anne Binsack will be invited to attend to discuss St. Monica's school ans its relationship to the configuration. The question of a joint parish project or a diocesan school needs to be addressed as well as the question of how this would effect OLGC's relationship with Holy Family.

Father Bob Gaudio will be chairperson for future meetings.

Next meeting is scheduled for Sunday Nov. 17, 1991 at 1:30 P.M. at St/ Monica's rectory if St. Mary Anne is available. Otherwise it will be Nov. 22 at 7:30 P.M. Another meeting will be Sunday Dec. 1, 1991 at 1:30 P.M.
