

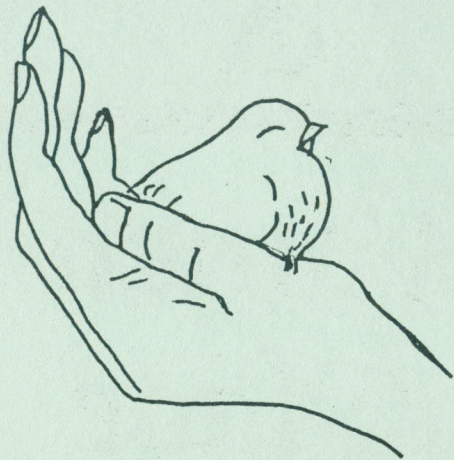

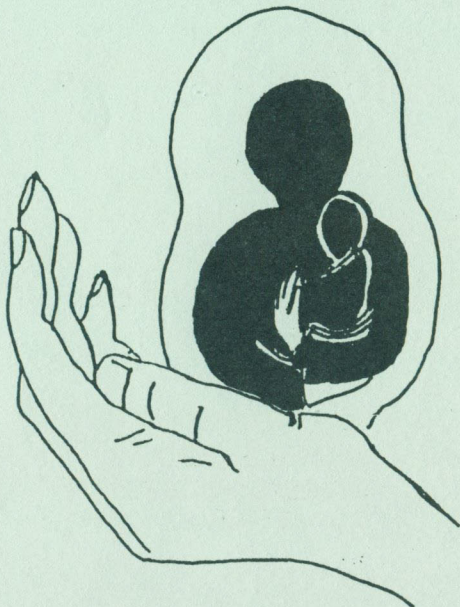

# Women's Place

**W**omen's Place is a 12-bed shelter for mothers with children and individual women who have no permanent home. Each resident receives a private room and meals. A caring staff offers both support and information to help residents make significant improvements in their life circumstances.

**P**re-school children find a welcoming home at Women's Place, which is equipped with a playroom, toys and cribs. A strong emphasis is placed on helping mothers to develop parenting skills.

Emergency shelter is available for up to 30 days. Transitional shelter is available to women seeking a safe place to sort out their lives and to implement a plan of personal growth.

**T**he staff is composed of paid and volunteer members available on a 24-hour basis. They teach social, homemaking and employment skills and link residents with resources in the community.

Funding sources include the Monroe County Department of Social Services, the New York State Department of Social Services Housing Homeless and Assistance Program (HHAP) and private donations.

Women's Place is located in a residential neighborhood at 146 Hobart Street, Rochester, New York, 14611, approximately one half mile west of the Bull's Head area.
