CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

SAINT MONICA'S CHURCH.

WHEREAS, in pursuance of Chapter Seven Hundred and Twenty-three of the Laws of Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-five, entitled "An Act in Relation to Religious Corporations, Constituting Chapter Forty-two of the General Laws", and the Acts amendatory and supplementary thereto, the Right Reverend Bernard J. McQuaid, Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Rochester, the Very Reverend James P. O'Hare, Vicar-General of said Diocese, and the Reverend John P. Brophy, the Rector of the Roman Catholic Church now known as "Saint Monica's Church", in the City of Rochester, in said County, have selected Joseph P. Henry and Michael J. Toomey, two lay members of said church, according to the provisions of said law, and for the purpose of incorporating said church;

Now, therefore, we, the said Bernard J. McQuaid, Bishop as aforesaid, James P. O'Hare, Vicar-General as aforesaid, John P. Brophy, Rector as aforesaid, and Joseph P. Henry and Michael J. Toomey, the lay members aforesaid, all of whom are natural persons, of full age, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of New York, do further, in pursuance of the provisions of said law and for the purpose aforesaid, hereby certify that the name by which we and our successors shall be known and distinguished as a body corporate, is SAINT MONICA'S CHURCH, and that the principal place of worship of said corporation is intent

to be in the said City of Rochester.
