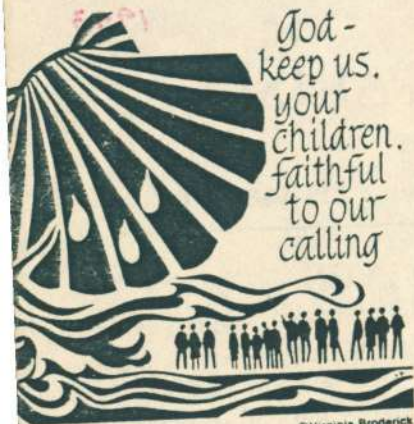

From Father Dave's Desk

I went with the intention of saying No! Because we cannot deliver, I went to a meeting of local pastors and diocesan officials with the intention of saying sorry to a multiparish religious education (Fall '92-Spring '93).

I shared our experience. My colleagues heard it. "We are going through the same thing." Religious education is competing for peoples' attention. And losing. Times, places and peoples just don't jell. The problem is star; the second largest number of church going people in the USA (after Catholics) is disaffected Catholics. They are people in search of community. Why only get turned on when you get turned out?

We need a new look, a new approach, a new context. Relig-

ious education within a new evangelization, as a continuous call to conversion. New settings within family, and within the community gathered for worship.
Are we in need of a new Pentecost? Or in need of recognizing the Pentecost all around us? A great challenge to us here at SSPP is how to do religious ed..... should we talk first about a new evangelization outreach? To my friends I didn't say no and I didn't say yes. To you, I say, "Come, let's talk stuff out."

Recently deceased To Florence Roth on the loss of her sister and our eldest parishoner, Ethel Kilpeck (DeDe) we express sympathy. Ethel was ninety five and life long member of the parish. Even such a long life was prologue to a rest which we pray will be eternal! Please keep the families of Mary Ellen Gleason and Joan Joslin in your prayers. Both their fathers are hospitalized. Joan is the lady who trains us in singing.
