We need a new look, a new approach, a new context. Relig-

ious education within a new evangelization, as a continuous call to conversion. New settings within family, and within the community gathered for worship.

Are we in need of a new Pentecost? Or in need of recognizing the Pentecost all around us? A great challenge to us here at SSPP is how to do religious ed..... should we talk first about a new evangelization outreach? To my friends I didn't say no and I didn't say yes. To you, I say, "Come, let's talk stuff out."
