

PARISH COUNCIL *

This coming September, we will start our plans for electing a parish council which will be an effective aid in the progress of our parish.

The Second Vatican Council has requested that each parish have a council composed of laymen, who together with the priests will share in the administration of a parish, in both spiritual and temporal affairs.

The greater participation on the part of the laity should encourage a greater spiritual progress, and more temporal stability to our parish apostolate.

It will be necessary that all parishioners participate in the forming of this council so that it will have universal support and realistic representation in all areas.

-EXPENSES WILL INCREASE-

We expect that in the coming year, our school will cost more than the preceding year because of the increase in our present day economy.

The salaries of our teachers have been raised. These will amount to over \$32,000.00 in respect to approximately \$25,000.00 the past year. Also other rising costs will put the school budget within the \$50,000.00 range. The exact figures are not yet available, but will be given in a few weeks. You can understand our difficulties when you see the rising expenses, and the decreasing income each Sunday.

We must seriously try to do everything we can to try to increase our income so that we can meet the expenses which are mounting with the inflation of our present economic situation.
