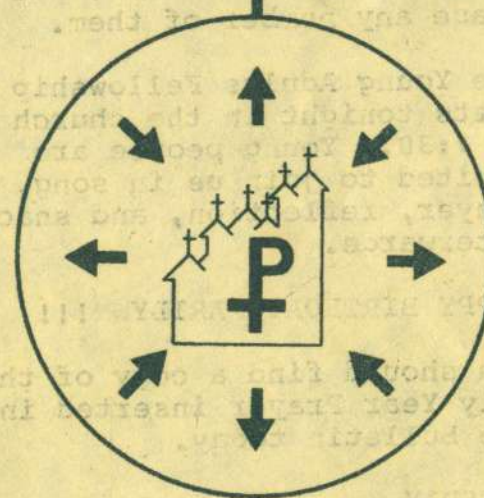

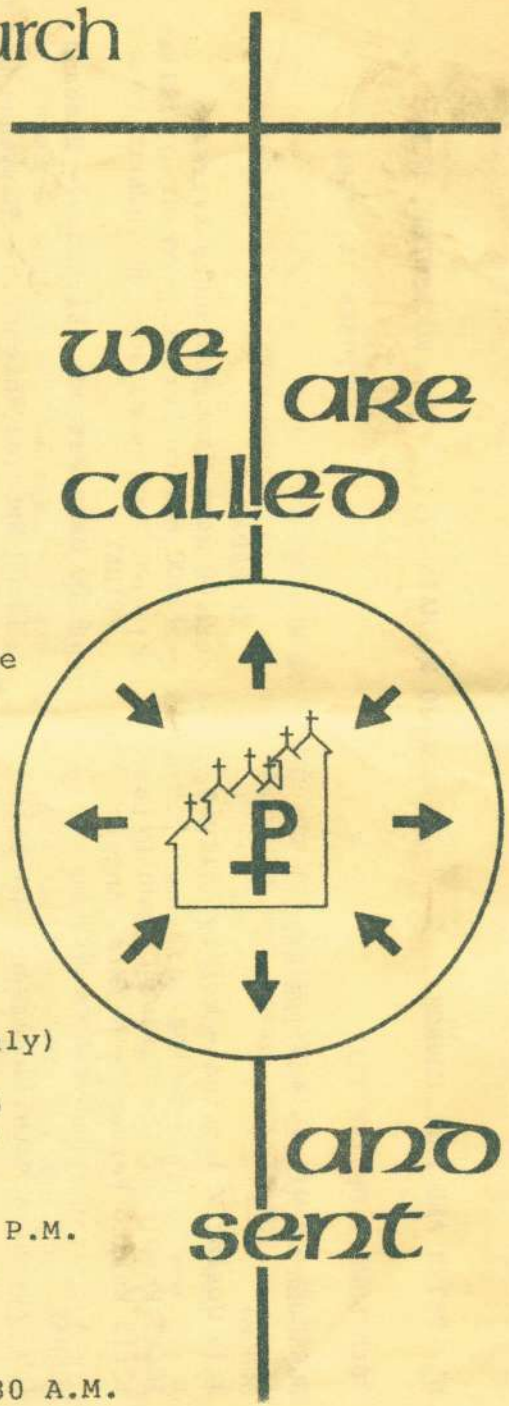

Your Diocesan Pastoral Council representatives will be present to report on the DPC convocation in September and to listen to your Concerns.

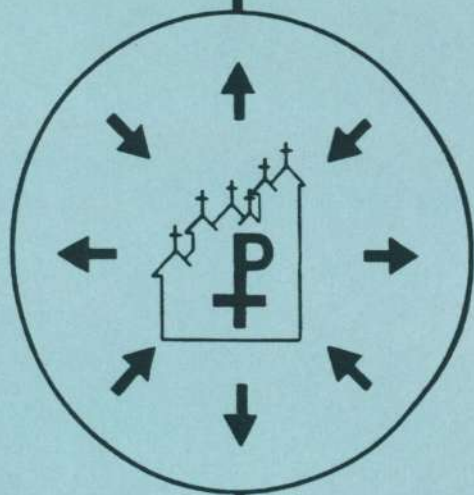
