the management FROM FATHER DAN'S DESK

The festival which celebrates the Lord's birth began Tuesday evening and continues through the feast of the Epiphany - in all, twelve days of Christmas. The readings, prayers and hymns assigned to these days are some of the most beautiful and inspiring of the entire church year. The Christmas homily of Pope Leo the Great is one of my favorites:

"Dearly beloved, today our Savior is born; let us rejoice! Sadness should have no place on the birthday of life. The fear of death has been swallowed up; life brings us joy with the promise of eternal happiness. No one is shut out from this joy; all share the same reason for rejoicing. Our Lord, victor over sin and death, finding no one free from sin, came to free us all. Let the saints rejoice-seeing the palm of victory at hand. Let the sinner be glad-receiving the offer of forgiveness. Let the pagan take courage-being summoned to life... Christians, remember your dignity,... (D)o not forget that you have been rescued from the power of darkness and brought into the light of God's kingdom."

History is filled with men and women who believed these words and took their Christian dignity seriously. Some are honored within the Twelve Days of Christmas with special feasts including martyrs [Stephen and the Holy Innocents], an apostle and evangelist [John], two of the four great doctors of the Eastern church [Basil the Great and Gregory Nazianzen], an American woman [Elizabeth Ann Seton], and even a feast honoring Mary, the Mother of God.

These holy men and women were transparent reflections of Jesus to the world and encouragement for us as we work to become holy. Who knows, someday one of us may be celebrated in the church's calendar as a saint!

The Christmas season is only a few days old. Rejoice in the Lord's birth! Rejoice in God's generous gift of Life! Merry Christmas!
