



#### WHERE NEW SS. PETER AND PAUL'S CHURCH WILL BE BUILT.

Property in West Avenue acquired by SS. Peter and Paul's Roman Catholic parish, at a cost of \$55,000. At the west end of the site, the Chamberlain residence will be made use of as a convent by the Sisters of Notre Dame, the teaching staff of the parochial school connected with the church. At the other end of the site, the Mason home will be utilized as a rectory for Rev. J. Emil Gefell, rector of the church. The D. M. Anthony and the Wilkins houses, between, will be torn down for the erection of the new church. The total frontage of the site is 260 feet, and it has a depth of 199 feet. With the two present buildings on the site to be used for convent and rectory, there will remain to be built the church, a school and a Y. M. C. C. clubhouse. Negotiations are under way for property in Brown Street, on which to build the school, and enough land will be purchased to accommodate a large playground.
