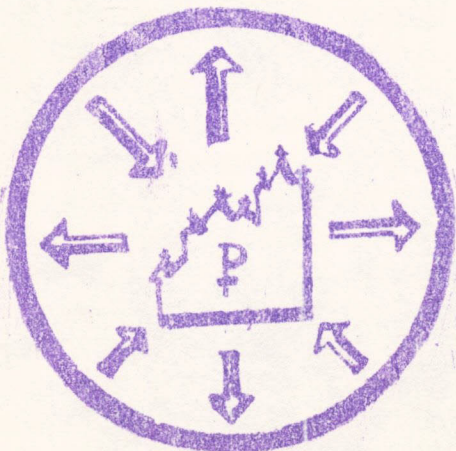

THE MIRACLE OF THE LOAVES AND THE FISHES

NARRATOR
