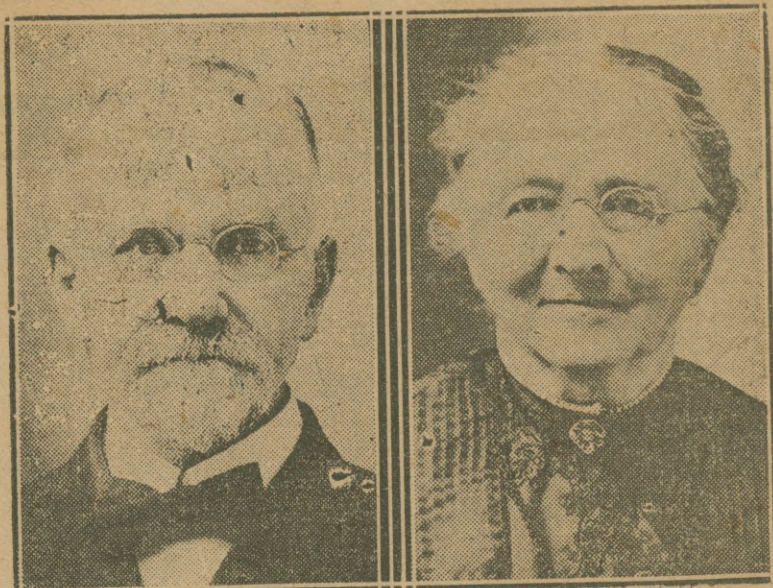


Three Sons Will Offer Up Mass On Parents' Golden Anniversary
